Medical Imaging Program

Scholarship assistance for the **Medical Imaging** program will fund 100% of required tuition (minus grants and scholarships) for all **Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences** faculty-taught courses and the general education courses provided by **Alvernia University** beginning with semester three of the Medical Imaging program.



Surgical Technology and Diagnostic Medical Sonography Programs

Scholarship assistance for the **Diagnostic Medical Sonography** and **Surgical Technology** programs will fund 100% of required tuition for all **Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences** faculty-taught courses and the general education courses provided by **Alvernia University** for the entire program.

Nursing Program

Scholarship assistance for the **Nursing** program will fund 100% of required tuition (minus grants and scholarships) for all **Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences** faculty-taught courses and the general education courses provided by **Alvernia University** as part of Years 2 and 3 in the Nursing program.

The scholarship will not fund fees (application fees, acceptance fees, health fees, background checks, semester fees, skills lab membership fees etc.), uniforms, meals, dormitory/housing costs, textbooks, or other living expenses.

Employment Obligation Periods

Employment obligation periods will vary by program and academic year within the program at time of acceptance of scholarship. Upon completion of the student's respective program, scholarship recipients agree to accept/maintain employment working 0.5 FTE or higher on any shift, in any assignment within any of the Reading Hospital units or positions. With Reading Hospital Human Resource Department approval, the student employment obligations can also be fulfilled at any Tower Health affiliate under certain conditions. Availability of scholarships will vary by program.
