### RETENTION RATE

Percentage of students who started on the enrollment date (who began Paramedic coursework) who are enrolled, graduated, or stopped out (i.e., reasonably expected to re-enroll at a later date).

### ANNUAL CREDENTIALING EXAMS

Credentialing examination pass rate is defined as the number of graduates who pass the professional credentialing examination on first attempt compared with the number of graduates within that cohort who took the examination. (NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMTs) THIS SHOWS THE RESULTS OF THE COHORT FOR THE GRADUATING YEAR.
